Dear Sirs,

During the summer of 1962 my husband and I took the Sabin oral polio vaccine. We both are now [REDACTED] years old.

Two weeks after taking vaccine I began to have unusual pains in lower abdomen and frequent voiding. Then I started having a rectal disorder as well.

There may be no connection between my ailments and the vaccine but I would like you to confirm as to the possibility of side effect.

I went to an urologist and he treated me for "Hunners ulcer". I am still taking irrigations every four weeks.

As to the rectal trouble, saw a rectal specialist and he treated me for something called "condymalata". After four months this cleared up externally, but must return in Sept. for a scope and possible desiccation performed in the hospital.

Until I took the vaccine my health seemed fine. I realize that at my age things do "run down".....so I would like you advise me if you think you could help me in any way. Perhaps you could touch on something that my Doctors are unable to see or know.

I will greatly appreciate your time in answering this letter, either way, it will relieve my mind.
