In observing the trends of dosage recommendations for Sabin Vaccine, I have been puzzled as to the discrepancies of dosage, as recommended by you and by others.


Most of the schedules (to which we practitioners are exposed) conform to the pattern given in the first section of the enclosed card.

The alternate schedule is close to what I have been using. I have not seen any published comments by you re:

- 1) Initial use of trivalent vs. single type vaccine in infancy.
- 2) Need for multiple repeat doses of trivalent vaccine.

In one recent article, I believe you recommend only one follow-up dose, after initial complete series. Although safe and harmless, are the repeated doses (of ~~few~~ recommended) necessary or desirable?
