
In a recent lead article on Toxoplasmosis in the New England Journal there was a reference to a dye test devised by you and Dr. Feldman.

Just recently, I have been caring for a family with three cases which clinically resembled infectious mononucleosis, without confirmatory Paul-Bunnell tests or distinctly positive differential smears. The first case appeared in a ten year old boy recently returned from camp who developed fever, malaise, lymphadenopathy, and weakness. His mother had a similar illness three weeks later, followed by a younger brother the next week.

Is it possible to have this family tested for Toxoplasmosis in this area. In other words, what nearby medical centers are equipped to perform the Sabin-Feldman test?
