Dear Dr. Sabin,

I enclose the manuscript of a ~~XXXXX~~ preliminary communication read before the European Association of Clinical Pathologists. You will see that although the morbid anatomical findings in experimental animals resemble those in Toxoplasmosis, there are also differences such as the marked lymphatic spread. Calcification is not mentioned in the paper, but was seen on few occasions in lymph nodes. Your Toxoplasma immune serum did not neutralise our infective agent. A few sera were tested at the same time, but unfortunately none of these had neutralising antibodies. The matter is being investigated further and I should be very grateful for any suggestions you may make.

P.S. I am sending by the same mail a smear from the spleen of an experimental guinea pig and I should be very grateful for your opinion.
