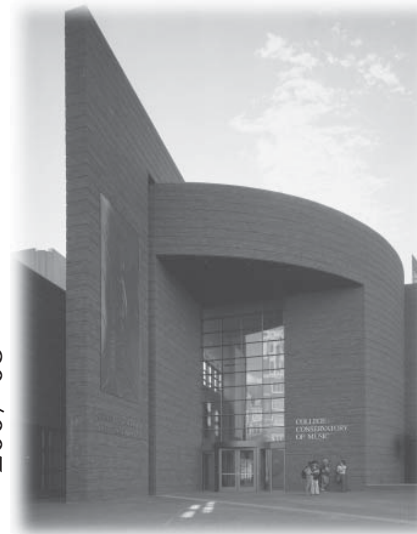

In Memoriam: Gerhard Samuel (1924-2008)

This evening’s performance is dedicated to the memory of Gerhard Samuel, internationally renowned conductor, composer and pedagogue, who passed away in March. Maestro Samuel taught at CCM from 1976 to 1996, and as director of the Philharmonia, he tirelessly championed avant-garde music and brought the orchestra to international standing, culminating in a performance at the International Mahler Festival in Paris in 1989. His influence as an artist and mentor is far-reaching, and he will be truly missed.
