Test your investigative skills and explore the library for clues to solve a murder mystery.

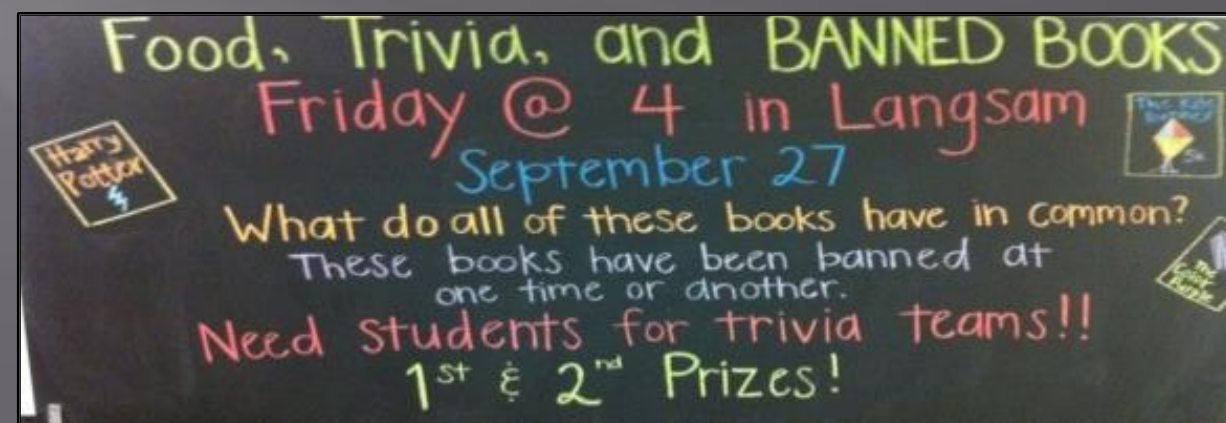
**Celebrate the Chinese New Year**

Come see *the world's smallest book!*

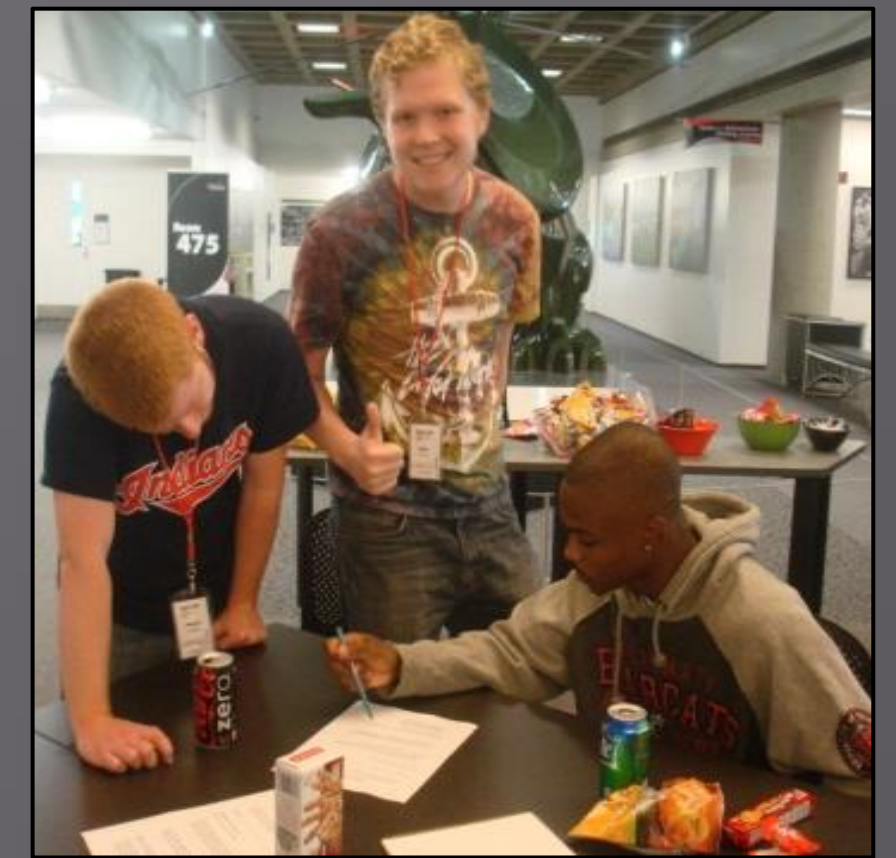
**Gays Gone By....The Struggle Continues**

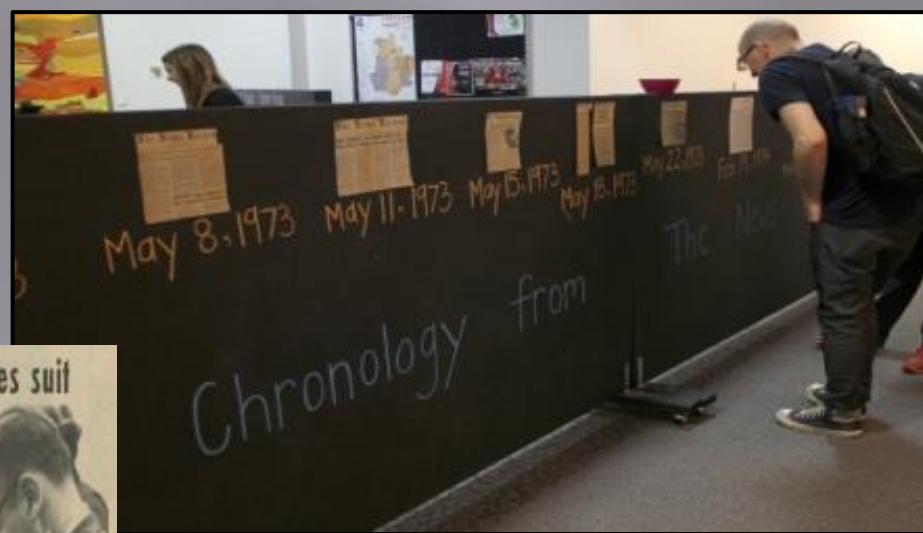
