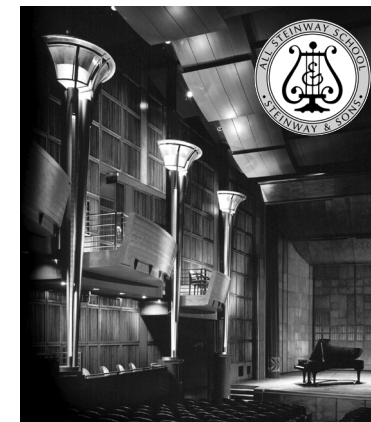

Originally premiered in 1969 for the dedication of Cincinnati's Rockdale Temple, Dave Brubeck's *The Gates of Justice* was a co-commission by CCM and the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, with a premiere conducted by Erich Kunzel. The text is drawn from the Hebrew Bible, speeches of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Negro Spirituals, the writings of Hillel and lyrics by the composer's wife, Lola Brubeck.
