Dear Doctor Sabin:

I have your letter of the 25th of November. Thank you for permission to use the information received.

Since requesting this information of you, I have had an opportunity to talk to S. A. Keeble, a veterinarian from England. He is with Glaxo Laboratories and over the last few years they have used about 15,000 monkeys. They have been able to recognize a clinical stage of infection with B-virus in the Rhesus monkey, reported by Keeble in 1958.

He mentioned that there have been cases in Great Britain. Does the figure quoted in your letter of the 25th include cases in countries other than the United States?
