Dear Albert:

I am enclosing the copy of a letter that I sent to Dr. Kumm, as he asked me for the developments of the d work.

We are now preparing a number of stocks of reversions from your present stocks and will send them to you as soon as they are ready. We are also going to repeat all the determinations with the most significant stocks. Then we shall send you the complete results in detail.

It seems to me that we don't have any good type 1 stock. You had mentioned a new one in one of your letters: could you send it to us? Maybe the testis enrichment method will yield some interesting strains.

We are going to try on the testis procedure to isolate several independent attenuated strains of type 1; they may be an excellent material for studying recombination by using the acid-selective technique for d^+ recombinants.
