Conservator's Note

The object was received with a damaged cloth spine. An aged and brittle tattle tape had punctured two holes in the center of the spine. Protruding out of the two holes, the metal tattle tape was posing a stabbing hazard to users. The tattle tape fragments were extracted out of the spine of the book. Losses in the spine were filled with numerous layers of kozo tissue that were adhered with wheat starch paste. The corners of the cover were soft and delaminating, therefore, they were consolidated with wheat starch paste. The inner hinges of the cover were reinforced with Usu Mino kozo tissue and wheat starch paste to repair breaks along the endsheet folds.
