

Dear Doctor Sabin,

Professor Stuart Harris asked me to send you our results so far with your Type III attenuated poliovirus vaccine. Fourteen boys in one ward of an orthopaedic hospital were given two doses of British Salk vaccine three weeks apart and 15 to 20 weeks later were fed 100,000 TCD<sub>50</sub> of attenuated vaccine. The neutralising antibodies were tested by the tube method for cytopathogenicity.

The monkey virulence tests are not finished yet, but we thought you might be interested in these few results.
