I am sorry for the delay in replying to your letter of 13 June concerning Dr. Hugo Dunlap Smith. I have had to circulate the letter through our various departments in an attempt to see if there was any possibility of utilizing him within our present allocations for personnel.

I am sorry to say that we cannot take on Dr. Smith because of lack of position vacancies, and it is not likely that one will occur prior to the spring of 1953. As you no doubt know, in the period immediately following the onset of the Korean affair the School did take on an appreciable number of individuals with two years of service expected. Most of these individuals will not begin to leave the service until the spring of 1953, and under our present ceilings I am unable to add additional personnel.
