This is to tell you how deeply I appreciated your letter of March 16 containing the information that I asked you to supply me. This is just what I wanted to know and I think it is quite remarkable that the so-called services have brought in so large an amount of foreign exchange into Israel. It is also heartening to know that the actual export of goods is increasing at such a good rate.

I was very happy to see you the other night and hope that our paths will cross again in the near future.

I expect to be in Israel twice this year, once at the end of April for a meeting of the Board of Governors of the Weizmann Institute and again at the end of June for a meeting of the Board of Governors of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
