Dear Dr. Winsser:

Since writing you on March 7, 1950, I have consulted Mr. Charles P. Taft, who has discussed with me an advisory opinion given on August 17, 1948, by Mr. H. J. L'Heureux, Chief of the Visa Division of the State Department, which is an interpretation of an information sheet dated March, 1946, defining the word "professor" as contained in the Foreign Service Regulations.

I am, therefore, writing you this letter to explain that the offer contained in my letter of March 7, 1950, is well within the definition and advisory opinion referred to. As Research Associate at the Children's Hospital Research Foundation, you will have faculty rank in the Department of Pediatrics of the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine.

The arrangement between the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine and the Children's Hospital Research Foundation is that the Director of the Children's Hospital is the head of the Department of Pediatrics of the University of Cincinnati and is also the Director of the Children's Hospital Research Foundation. All professional appointments in the Hospital or Research Foundation are simultaneously appointments on the faculty of the University of Cincinnati. In addition to this, as Research Associate in the Department of Pediatrics of the University of Cincinnati you will not be giving any formal courses, although you may occasionally share in such instruction under professors who do give such courses, but you will be supervising research and outside

reading done by the students of the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine.
In connection with your appointment, you will be associated with the University
in order to confer benefit of your knowledge to students rather than to pursue
your own studies.
