Dear Dr. Thayer:

This is in reply to your letter about your patient with "probably tuberculous uveitis" on whom you would like to have a test for toxoplasmosis. In my opinion, there is no evidence at the present time that acquired uveitis can be caused by toxoplasma. There is no point in my seeing this patient. However, if you would like to have a serologic test for toxoplasmosis, I would suggest that you send an abstract of the patient's history together with approximately 4 to 5 cc of serum, by air mail special delivery, to my former associate, Dr. Harry A. Feldman, Department of Medicine, Syracuse University Hospital of The Good Shepherd, Syracuse 10, New York.
