
Dear Doctor Sabin:-

I regret being so negligent in thanking you for the hyperimmune monkey serum. It arrived intact shortly after the first of the month. After the press of semester-end activities, I hope to make use of it.

Our difficulties with the Toxoplasma-injected guinea pigs are continuing and we find the same cytoplasmic inclusions in spleen and liver we demonstrated on your visit to our laboratory. As near as we can determine, they resemble the bodies described by Kurloff. Where this tangent will lead us we do not know. -- At present it is quite disturbing.
