My dear Howe:

Many thanks for your note. As far as I know, there are as yet no plans for having a meeting of the poliomyelitis group at Christmas time. As a matter of fact, I think it very unlikely that any meeting will be held at that time, first, because sufficient work has not yet been done since the last meeting to warrant discussion, and second, because none of the societies in which the members of this group are interested will meet around Christmas time this year. It is probable that the group will not meet again until the time of the International Microbiological Congress in September of 1939.
