Dear Dr. Rachmilewitz:

On November 9th there was a meeting in my house of a group of Cincinnati physicians together with Mr. Berkman of the Hebrew University office in the U. S. to discuss the possibility of raising funds in Cincinnati as a contribution to the Hebrew University - Hadassah Medical Center now under construction. It was decided that an attempt should be made to raise \$ 20,000.00 for some unit to be known as the Cincinnati Physicians Unit at the Medical Center. The consensus was that it should be given to the Medical Center without specific designation, to be used for whatever unit might be needed. There were some, however, who suggested that it might perhaps be easier to raise the funds if one could designate some specific unit for which these funds could be used. I was asked, therefore, to write to you to inquire your own opinion on this matter and also to ask you if you might indicate some units in the proposed Medical Center for which a contribution of about \$ 20,000.00 might be especially helpful.

I often think of the interesting days that I spent in Jerusalem with you.
