Dear Mr. or Miss Regis Fanchette,
whichever the case may be since I do
not know whether Regis is the name of
a man or of a woman:

The post^{er} that you were kind enough to send me on
27 August arrived only a few days ago and I was very glad indeed
to see it. I must say that I have had no word whatever about the
use of this vaccine in Mauritius either from Dr. Losconszi or
from Dr. Gear who, I presume, has supplied the vaccine. I knew
that something was going on in Mauritius because Dr. Lewthwaite
of the Colonial Office in London told me something about it at a
meeting of the British Medical Research Council that I attended
on September 17th. I would indeed be grateful for more news of
what happened in Mauritius.
