Dear Dr. Pratt:

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare Appropriations Act for fiscal year 1966, which became law on August 31, 1965, includes a statement to the effect that no research project may be funded for 100% of its total cost. The Bureau of the Budget is currently developing rules to provide firm guidelines for a uniform Federal Government approach to cost sharing by grantee institutions. Pending the issuance of such guidelines each project research grant award made after August 31, 1965, is being amended to reflect the new language in the Appropriations Act.


Accordingly, grant award CA 94557-07 dated July 14, 1965

is amended to include the following statement under remarks:

"ACCEPTANCE OF THIS GRANT OBLIGATES YOU TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE TOTAL COSTS OF THE RESEARCH PROJECT BEING SUPPORTED."
(MORE SPECIFIC RULES OF COST SHARING WILL BE ISSUED SOON TO GOVERN FUTURE GRANTS.)
