Dear Albert,

Thank you for your letter of May 19, 1981

First allow me to congratulate you for having secured the cooperation of the Italian Authorities for a collaborative clinical trial on immunization against measles by the respiratory route: Bravo !!!

I also want to mention that the afternoon spent with Heloisa and your kind-self in the Castle will always be one of the nicest experiences I had... and I am looking forward very much to your visit in September. Please let me know the dates when I can look forward to have you stay with us: Young people should be together... Enclosed please find photocopies of the references you asked for:

I also enclose some other relevant material in the letter of Warren H. Pearse M.D., Executive Director of The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists of November 4, 1977 and my reply to him dated November 26, 1977, as well as, the full bibliographical references, which are the building blocks for my Cancer-Hypothesis as they appear in print in the Spanish text of my Thesis of 1968 (I gave you the English translation as published in "KREBSGESCHEHEN", the German Cancer Journal, in 1977 where the bibliographical references have been omitted by the Editors, unfortunately).

As far as my discovery of the Amnion Anti-HCG principle let me say briefly that it all started with my reading in Reed's textbook of obstetrics (reference No. 43 in my Spanish Thesis of 1968) quote: "...With rare exceptions, the fetus is unharmed by malignant disease in the mother...", and, further on: "there is evidence both for and against the contention that pregnancy influences the rate or course of neoplasms..." It was here that I started a thorough review and investigation of the literature, and I found the reason for the apparent contradiction, as follows (Graetz A., Krebsgeschehen, 1977/4, p.84): "The evidence both for acceleration and slow down of tumor growth in pregnant women seems to be linked to chorionic gonadotropin hormones in terms of growth acceleration and to the anti chorionic gonadotropin principle in terms of growth inhibition". Reference No. 17 in my Spanish text is: Emge, L.A., The influence of Pregnancy on Tumor Growth; Am. J. Obst. Gyn. 28, 1934, p. 682, describes the inhibition of tumor growth in pregnancy. Whereas, Smith F.R., The effect of Pregnancy on Malignant Tumors, Am. J. Obst. Gynec. 34, 1937 p.616 describes the acceleration of tumor growth in pregnancy, Reference 52 in Spanish text

Finally, enclosed are some documents showing that my Patents and pending Patents in some 18 countries are now in the custody, and "in trust" with the Economic Minister of the Government of Israel in New York City. They have been assigned by me for payment of financial "Reparation" to the Palestinian Refugees as compensation for property abandoned when they left Israel in 1948 (the way Germany paid Jews who left before Hitler came to power in 1939, after the war). I value my American Patent and my Patent Applications which are still pending since 1965 as between 34.000 and 50.000 Million U.S. Dollars... But Banks for Afetrbirth need the support of the Jewish American community to counterbalance the hostility of the pharmacological industry.

Let me end this letter that until I met you I felt like a lonely man in the empire of the dead and the kinsmen of the dead... Your vitality and Heloisa's kindness and good humour shows: we have the same fire burning in our hearts!
