Dear Dr. Sabin:

Few days ago I came back from the United States, where I went to attend the meeting on measles immunization in Bethesda. The meeting was held 7-IO November, and afterwards I spent some time in N.I.H., then went to REX Boston and New-York. On my way home I visited London too. This is the reason why I answer so late your letter of November 8. I am so sorry I could not give you clinical data on the reported cases, because the time does not permit me, what I am going ton do later, as soon as possible.

You will find enclosed here some data I had with me, and I hope it

may be of help for you.

As far as I know polio morbidity rate for the whole of Yugoslavia was about the same as the one in Serbia. The whole country was vaccinated with live polio vaccine except Croatian where Koprowsky type I and type 3 were used, type 2 was not used in Croatia at all.

As to the laboratory data from other republics than Serbia-I do not know anything. It has been planned-all reported cases to be tested virologically in Serbia, but unfortunatly I was not able to obtain the specimens from all reported cases.

As soon as I get the data you want-I will write you.
