I take the liberty of sending you, as you allowed me to do, our paper about the evolution of the polio lesion in cells infected in vitro with the virus.

The paper is chiefly based on the results of phase contrast microcinematography of living material and partially on previous cytochemical studies on fixed cells.


As far as I know nobody before us has described in detail what happens in the polio diseased cells in vitro and I think I have to go ahead without delay in publishing our data.
