Dear Mr. Paul:

Enclosed you find three bottles of insect repellent. A few drops in your hands will suffice to cover most of your face, neck, hands and ankles.

While you are in India and the Philippines it is well to remember that the mosquitoes which bite during the day are also not only a nuisance, but can transmit disease. It may, therefore, be advisable to use repellent not only at night, but also during the day.

I should like to caution you if you are inclined to sleep in the raw, not to put any repellent in the vicinity of the groin, because it is terribly irritating in that region.
