Dear Col. Orr,

Last week after talking with you in Columbus I contacted Mr. Scharig at AMSAV-S10 in St. Louis, Mo. It seems that he cannot request obsolete or damaged helicopter parts be sent from National Guard bases. It appears that he has no authority to do so. He did suggest however, that you might be able to intervene in the matter.

It is my understanding that some of the missing parts might be on the National Guard bases in Pennsylvania. Perhaps Col. Howard could offer some assistance. Without the missing parts the project is in jeopardy and many, many folks here in Cincinnati are looking forward to the Triceracopter Americus's completion in the not too distant future. Time is of the essence as I am trying to adhere to a rather rigid schedule.

One other National Guard base that has OH-6As is in New Jersey. If my information is correct, I understand they damaged two OH-6As last year.

Any help that you can offer will be greatly appreciated. Thus far, I've invested over a year's time in pursuit of needed studio space, materials and funding, not to mention about \$1,000.00, to date, out of pocket expense on the project.
